The Kayenta Chapter will be hiring 16 students for the upcoming summer. Each group of four students will work for two weeks according to the following schedule:

- Group 1: Start June 2, 2026
- Group 2: Starts June 15, 2026
- Group 3: Starts June 29, 2026
- Group 4: Starts July 13, 2026

This entry-level position offers an opportunity for high school students to learn how to apply for a job, go through an interview process, and gain valuable on-the-job experience. By participating, high school students will have the chance to meet financial needs, foster personal growth, and engage directly with the local community.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:
