KAYENTA CHAPTER REQUESTING THE INSTALLATION OF SAFE PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALKS AND REVIEW OF SPEED LIMIT ALONG U.S. HIGHWAY 163 WITHIN KAYENTA TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS,

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), the Kayenta Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1(B), the Kayenta Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction(s) when necessary and make recommendation(s) to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action(s); and
3. U.S. Highway 163 serves as a major transportation corridor through Kayenta Township, including the stretch from the junction of U.S. Highway 160/163 to the traffic signal at the intersection of U.S. Highway 163 and Navajo Route 6486; and
4. There are currently no designated or safe pedestrian crossing areas along this section of U.S. Highway 163, creating hazardous conditions for community members, including students, elders, and visitors; and
5. Numerous incidents, including injuries and fatalities, have occurred due to unsafe pedestrian crossings along this roadway; and
6. Kayenta Township and Kayenta Chapter continues to experience growth in population, traffic, and pedestrian activity, increasing the urgency to address pedestrian safety concerns; and
7. Community members have expressed strong concerns regarding the lack of pedestrian infrastructure and the dangers posed to youth, especially during school sessions; and
8. The current posted speed limit of 40 miles per hour along this stretch of U.S. Highway 163 is considered too high by community members, particularly within a populated area where pedestrians are frequently present; and
9. Reports of speeding vehicles along this corridor further exacerbate safety risks to pedestrians and motorists alike; and
10. The Kayenta Chapter seeks collaboration with relevant agencies and stakeholders, including the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT), Navajo Division of Transportation (NDOT), Navajo County, Navajo Nation Department of Public Safety, Navajo Nation Government, and Kayenta Township, to address these safety concerns.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Kayenta Chapter formally requests the installation of at least two (2) marked and well-lit pedestrian crosswalks, including appropriate signage and safety measures, along U.S. Highway 163 between the U.S. Highway 160/163 junction and the traffic signal light at U.S. Highway 163 and Navajo Route 6486.
2. The Kayenta Chapter further requests consideration of additional pedestrian safety enhancements, including but not limited to pedestrian warning signals, flashing beacons, traffic calming measures, and improved lighting.
3. The Kayenta Chapter requests comprehensive review and reduction of the current speed limit along this stretch of U.S. Highway 163, particularly during school hours, to improve pedestrian and community safety.
4. The Kayenta Chapter calls upon ADOT, NDOT, Navajo County, Navajo Nation Department of Public Safety, Navajo Nation Government, and Kayenta Township to collaborate and take immediate action to evaluate, plan, and implement these safety improvements.
5. The Kayenta Chapter supports enforcement efforts to address speeding violations and promote safer driving behaviors within Kayenta Chapter and Kayenta Township.
6. The Kayenta Chapter affirms that these actions are necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents, particularly students, elderly, disabled and the youth.

WHEREAS,

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), the Kayenta Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1(B), the Kayenta Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction(s) when necessary and make recommendation(s) to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action(s); and
3. The Navajo Nation Election Administration has established qualifications for poll officials, including the ability to read and write in English, converse fluently in the Navajo language, attend required training, maintain impartiality, possess a valid driver's license, and meet all other requirements established by the Navajo Nation Election Administration; and
4. Mr. Wilson Begay has been recommended to serve as a Poll Official at the Kayenta Chapter Polling Site and is willing to fulfill the duties and responsibilities required by the Navajo Nation Election Administration; and
5. Mr. Wilson Begay shall be available to serve during the Navajo Nation Primary Election scheduled for July 21, 2026, and the Navajo Nation General Election scheduled for November 3, 2026; and
6. The Kayenta Chapter recognizes the importance of appointing qualified and responsible individuals to ensure fair, impartial, and efficient election operations for the registered voters of the Kayenta Chapter.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Kayenta Chapter hereby recommends and approves Mr. Wilson Begay to serve as a Poll Official for the Kayenta Chapter Polling Site for the 2026 Navajo Nation Primary Election on July 21, 2026, and the 2026 Navajo Nation General Election on November 3, 2026.

3. Per the Navajo Nation Budget Instruction Manual for Fiscal Year 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, and 2026, the Kayenta Chapter has budgeted for Pension expenses in Fund 02 (Navajo Nation General Fund), which is utilized for personnel expenses, such as Wages and Fringe benefits; and
4. Due to the turnover of the full-time staff positions at the Kayenta Chapter beginning in FY2021, payments were never made to the Defined Benefit Plan Contribution; and
5. After careful review and meeting with the Navajo Nation Retirement Services, the Kayenta Chapter is still eligible to participate in the Defined Benefit Plan; and
6. The Kayenta Chapter Manager was able to review the Personnel wages from Fiscal Year 2021 to the current fiscal year to determine what was still owed to the Defined Benefit Plan Contribution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
