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Protection Agency, which has the authority to investigate such concerns and address any identified illegal dumping sites.

- D. JoDonna Ward requested time to speak, and President Bailey granted her the floor.** Mrs. Ward stated that Navajo County Supervisor Fern Benally informed her that Kayenta Township Commission is not recognized by Navajo County as a governmental entity. Mrs. Ward further commented that KTC was intended to be overseen by the State of Arizona and/or Navajo County, and she questioned why Navajo County does not provide oversight of KTC. She also stated that four individuals approved the establishment of KTC-related taxes and that Chapter officials have previously requested the allocation of funds that were represented at the time KTC was established. Mrs. Ward noted that the Kayenta Chapter has passed several resolutions requesting that funds be allocated to the Chapter for community projects and needs. She stated that, to date, KTC has not provided any funding to the Kayenta Chapter from local tax revenues. Mrs. Ward encouraged community members to become more involved and remain active in local affairs.

VII. New Business:

A. Financial Report: Month of May 2026.

- JoDonna Ward thanked the Chapter for the financial report and transparency regarding Chapter funds. She then made critical remarks regarding Jarvis Williams in relation to his position as Town Manager. Mrs. Ward also commented on his candidacy for Navajo Nation Council Delegate. The remarks were noted as unprofessional and not in alignment with expected conduct during Chapter meetings.

During this exchange, President Bailey repeatedly called for a point of order in an effort to restore decorum; however, the calls were not observed as Mrs. Ward exited the meeting room. It was further noted that a loud verbal exchange continued outside the Chapter house and could be heard from within. Officials requested that the Chapter Manager verify that no issues were occurring outside.

President Bailey then proceeded with the financial report portion of the meeting.

- **President Albert Bailey noted that Peabody funds currently held in the Peabody account have not yet been rebudgeted.** He further stated that residents of the Black Mesa have requested home repairs and renovation assistance. President Bailey encouraged Black Mesa residents to return to the table to discuss rebudgeting of funds that were previously set aside for their use.
- Ben Blackhorse inquired whether there are funds set aside for a summer youth program.
- Secretary/Treasurer Dalton Singer explained that the Kayenta Chapter receives annual funding designated specifically for the summer youth employment program.
- **Sally Chee expressed concerns regarding home renovation applications.** She stated that several years ago, many community members submitted applications and packets for home renovations, weatherization, and home repair assistance. Mrs. Chee inquired

about the status of those applications and questioned why they have not been discussed or processed.

- Secretary/Treasurer Dalton Singer responded to Mrs. Chee's inquiry regarding home renovation applications. He stated that several years ago applications were submitted; however, the Chapter experienced a period without a Chapter Manager, and upon hiring a manager, application processing resumed. He further explained that operations were significantly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, during which Chapter services shifted to virtual and drive-through assistance, and many projects were placed on hold due to the focus on COVID-19 response efforts.

Mr. Singer also noted that during this period, the Chapter experienced the loss of both the Chapter Manager and Administrative Assistant, and Chapter facility renovations required relocation of records into conex containers. He stated that the current Chapter Manager is now reviewing older applications that have been located, though many are missing required documentation. He added that the Manager is working to contact applicants and is also accepting new applications.

Additionally, Mr. Singer stated that funds related to Peabody are set aside for Black Mesa residents. He also noted that Chilchinbeto Chapter reportedly invested its funds and earned approximately \$40,000 in interest. He suggested that Black Mesa residents be consulted regarding whether they would be interested in similar investment opportunities.
