APPROVING THE KAYENTA CHAPTER FY2025 INTO FY2026 CARRYOVER BUDGET TOTALING \$2,590,348.35.

WHEREAS,

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), the Kayenta Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1(B), the Kayenta Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction(s) when necessary and make recommendation(s) to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action(s); and
- 3. Pursuant to the Kayenta Chapter Resolution No. KT-06-112-10, The Kayenta Chapter approved the Five Management System (FMS) for use by the Kayenta Chapter in the lawful management of the Chapter as directed by the Navajo Department of Justice and Office of Auditor General; and
- 4. Pursuant to the Kayenta Chapter Five Management System- Fiscal Policy, it shall be the Kayenta Chapter's policy that no expenditures of Kayenta Chapter funds shall be made without an approved annual budget and that no expenditures shall exceed the budgeted amounts without prior approval by the Kayenta Chapter voting members; and
- Per the FY2026 Budget Instruction Manual, the Kayenta Chapter shall maintain a file containing all the laws, regulations, policies, fund management plans, and plans of operations referenced in the Chapter Budget Policies; and
- 6. Funds appropriated by the Navajo Nation Council are to be maintained in separate budgets or accounts, and those funds cannot be commingled; and
- 7. Pursuant to the Kayenta Chapter Five Management System- Fiscal Policy, the approved Kayenta Chapter operating budget may also include funds other than Navajo Nation appropriated funds, as well as carryover of the previous fiscal year's unexpended funds, except where the funding agency(s) do not permit the carryover of funds; and
- The Kayenta Chapter Administration, in consultation with the Kayenta Chapter Officials, has reviewed and made recommendations for the Kayenta Chapter FY2025 into FY2026 Carryover budget.

APPROVING THE KAYENTA CHAPTER'S SIHASIN CARRYOVER FUNDS FOR \$64,051.00 AND TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000.00 TO BE USED TOWARDS THE MAXIMUM FEASIBLE COST FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE NEW 3500 HEAVY DUTY FLAT BED TRUCK.

WHEREAS,

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), the Kayenta Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1(B), the Kayenta Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction(s) when necessary and make recommendation(s) to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action(s); and
- 3. Pursuant to NABIAP-24-24, an action relating to the Resources and Development Committee and the Naabik'yati' Committee, amending CJA-01-21 and NABIJN-18-22 to extend the deadline for the expenditures of Sihasin funds for Chapter heavy equipment purchases; and
- 4. The new deadline for Kayenta Chapter to purchase heavy equipment is December 31, 2025; and
- 5. If the funds are not spent or encumbered by December 31, 2025, the funds shall be reverted to the Sihasin fund; and
- Kayenta Chapter has been working diligently with the Navajo Nation Division of Community
 Development- Capital Project Management Department (CPMD) to bid out a heavy-duty flatbed
 truck; and
- 7. The \$64,051.00 Sihasin funds are not enough to purchase a heavy-duty flatbed truck; and
- 8. Kayenta Chapter has allocated funds in Fund 03-Land Claims Trust Fund totaling \$10,000.00 to be included toward the maximum feasible cost.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Kayenta Chapter hereby approves the Kayenta Chapter's Sihasin Carryover Funds for \$64,051.00 and to include additional funds in the amount of \$10,000.00 to be used towards the maximum feasible cost for the purchase of a new 3500 Heavy Duty Flat Bed Truck.
